D., the said sum of £ so ordered to be paid as aforesaid and also £ for his costs of suit by the Court here adjudged to the said A. B., which said monies and costs in the whole amount to £

At the margin of the rule opposite the words "therefore it is considered" write "judgment signed the day of A. D. " stating the day of signing judgment)

The like where the Case is referred to an Arbitrator.

(Proceed as in foregoing Form No. 27, down to the words "It was ordered," and then proceed as follows—It was ordered that the claim of the Plaintiff be referred to (stating the name of the referee and the substance of the rule or order of reference)—And afterwards the said (referee) by his Award (or certificate) did award (or certify) that there was due and payable from the said C. D., to the said A. B , the sum of £ and now on this day of 18 , (the day of signing judgment) it is manifestly shewn that the said C. D., hath not paid the said sum of £ . Therefore it is considered that the said A. B., do recover against the said C. D. , the said sum of £ , (the amount awarded or ordered) and also £ , for his costs. Conclude again the proceeding Form No. 27.)

These two Forms Nos. 27 and 28 may be so altered and modeled as to suit other Cases arising under section 84.
