attendant, and to fix the respective salaries of parties connected them with.

Meetings.

V. It shall be the duty of the said Board to meet quarterly, and oftens if they shall see occasion, in some convenient room in the Institution, or at the Town of St. Catherines; and at any such meeting a plurality of vote shall be binding and conclusive upon any matter before the Board, and three Directors shall constitute a quorum for the despatch of business.

Accounts to be made up quarterly.

VI. The accounts of the said Hospital shall be made up and ascentained by the Medical Superintendent, quarterly, upon the first Monday in January, April, July and October, in each year, to be submitted to the Board of Directors at each regular meeting.

Filling vacancies in Board. VII. Whenever any vacancies shall occur among the members of the said Board, it shall be lawful for the Governor to fill such vacancies by the appointment of other fit and proper persons, as often as need shall a quire.

Collection of the Tax to be imposed under this Act. VIII. The Collectors of Canal Tolls, at each extremity of the Welland Canal, shall oblige the masters of vessels passing through the Welland Canal, owned in this Province, to pay the rate of two shillings and six pence per month, which is hereby imposed upon each sailor or other person employed in such Vessel by the month or otherwise: and such Collectors shall grant a receipt upon such payment being made: And the officer of Customs at each port upon the above named Lakes shall be empowered to receive the said tax, and to demand the inspection of receipts from other parties empowered to grant the same, and in default of payment to detail such vessel until such payment shall be made: and any resistance to, or refusal or neglect to pay the said tax shall be visited with the same pain and penalties and forfeitures as are provided for resistance to, or for refusal or neglect to pay any duty of customs duly established by law.
