

An Act to incorporate the Buffalo, Chippawa and Niagara Falls Steamboat and Tramway Company.

WHEREAS the persons hereinafter named are desirous of being incorporated as a company for the purpose of building or otherwise acquiring and operating steamboats to ply between the City of Buffalo, in the State of New York, and some point on the Niagara or Welland River, at or near the village of Chippawa, in the Province of Ontario; calling at intermediate ports or places, with the powers incidentally necessary to the carrying out of such purpose, and also for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating in connection with their said steamboats a tramway, to be operated by steam, electricity or other motive power, between the port or place on the Niagara or Welland River, at or near the village of Chippawa, which shall be the Canadian terminal point of the said steamboats, and a point at or near the Town of Niagara Falls, in the Province of Ontario, with all the powers incidentally necessary for such last mentioned purpose and with the other powers hereinafter mentioned; and whereas a petition has been presented praying for the incorporation of a Company for that purpose, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. H. C. Sins, of Niagara Falls; William R. Brock, of the City of Toronto; W. E. Tench, of Chippawa; Leonard Glashan, of Niagara Falls; and John Harvey, and ——— Turner, both of the City of Hamilton, together with such persons as, under the provisions of this Act, become shareholders in the Company hereby incorporated, are hereby constituted a body corporate under the name of "The Buffalo, Chippawa and Niagara Falls Steamboat and Tramway Company," hereinafter called the Company.

Incorporation.

Corporate name.

2. The head office of the Company shall be in the Town of Niagara Falls, in the Province of Ontario, but the board of directors may establish one or more offices in other places in Canada or elsewhere.

Offices of the company.

3. The Company may build, charter or otherwise acquire and own and operate one or more steamboats to ply between the City of Buffalo, in the State of New York, one of the United States of America, and some port or place on the Niagara or the Welland River, at or near the village of Chippawa, in the Province of Ontario, with the right to call at
