Bombers Face Toughest Year

This year the 1970 version of the Red Bombers are going to find it a rough challenge to duplicate their undefeated season last year in the Bluenose Football Conference.

The Bluenose Conference, established in 1965 consists of seven Maritime Universitys and this season is expected to be the toughest and most evenly matched to date. No less than four teams, Mary's, Acadia, St. X. and Dalhousie are looking to topple the Bombers from their position as favorites for the title.

Training camp has been in progress since September 1, with 82 hopefuls at the start, down to a still large number of 76 after a week. There are 2 vacancies from last year's squad, most through graduation, but the nucleus of the last year's team remains intact for the upcoming season, a boost

to the coaches' opinion that a student can both play ball and keep his academic standing in order, if he wishes to work hard and apply himself.

Of the 22 freshmen trying out, 16 are from Montreal, where good recruiting has been one reason for a successful team, while only 5 are from the Maritimes and one from Ontario. The number of players trying out is expected to drop in the next few weeks to the 45 dressed for home games, with the system of not cutting players from the squad giving every player enough time to show his potential.

Coach Underwood hopes that this year's freshmen will take up the slack left from the few empty positions and will show enough desire to make them a winner.


