
With Cheque.

Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 14th instant, and the account which you forwarded from Mr F.W. Wallace for the funeral expenses of the late Mary Paul, I beg to say that in view of the fact that Dr McAllister gave the order, and as you have certified the account it has been paid by cheque for \$30.20 (No 170) herewith enclosed. But at the same time I may say that the Department considers the expenditure much too large for the burial of an Indian. The charge for such service should not exceed \$8.00 or \$10.00. Kindly inform Dr McAllister to this effect.
