

to school have been submitted to the Department of Justice for an opinion as to whether they are within the law and are of such as may be confirmed by the Governor in Council; and the Justice Department has made in pencil certain changes in the Rules passed by the Red and Flow Lake Bands, and the same changes should be made in those passed by the other four Bands.

The Rules and Regulations (five) annexed in order that the changes referred to may be made by the Chiefs and Councillors. The date should be changed and be returned to the Department as soon as possible. These Rules were by some perhaps filed away in the Department without the necessary
