SIR:-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 26th instant No. 16, inclosing an application from Mr. F. H. Graham, of Calgary, for permission to prospect on the Morley Reserve for coal.

In reply I beg to say that the permission asked for may be granted for one year, on the distinct understanding, however, that if coal is found, disposition thereof will only be made in such manner as may be determined, after surrender of the coal rights by the Indians, and on such terms as may be considered advisable in their interest.
