force or fire brigade or a warden or officer of a penitentiary, prison, lunatic asylum or mental hospital, the Board shall grant him an order postponing his military training until further notice unless the Board is of opinion that the man is not essential to the efficient administration of such force, brigade or institution; and the Board may cancel such postponement order at any time if it is satisfied that the man has ceased to be essential to the efficient administration of the force, brigade or institution.

(2) If, upon an application under this part for a postponement order, the Board is satisfied that the applicant is a bona fide candidate or student for the Ministry of a religious denomination eligible to supply chaplains to the armed forces, the Board shall grant him an order postponing his military training until further notice unless the Board is of opinion that the man is not essential to the well-being of the community; and the Board may cancel such postponement order at any time if it is satisfied that the man has ceased to be essential to the well-being of the community.

Doukhobors, Mennonites and Conscientious

All. (1) If, upon an application under this part for a postponement order the Board is satisfied that the applicant is a member of the denominations of Christians called Mennonites or a member of the Community of Doukhobors who immigrated to Canada pursuant to the arrangements evidenced by the Order in Council of the thirteenth day of August, eighteen hundred and seventy-three and by the Order in Council of the sixth day of December, eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, respectively, or by any of the descendants of such immigrants who have continued without interruption to be members of the <sup>said</sup> sect or denomination of Christians or of <sup>the</sup> said Community of Doukhobors and who have resided without interruption in Canada, the Board shall grant him an order postponing his military training until further notice; and the Board
