To all persons to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Know ye, that we Wabekanyne, Sabandan, Wabamip, Waniapanant, Okema-  
penes, and Potahquan, Sachems and Chief warriors and principal women of the Mes-  
sague nation of Indians in the Province of Upper Canada, For and in consideration  
of the sum of One hundred pounds good and lawful money of the said Province  
to us in hand well and truly paid before the enrolling and delivery hereof, on the  
part and behalf of his Britannick Majesty, have given, granted, bargained, sold,  
aliened, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents, do give, grant, bar-  
gain, alien, release, convey and confirm unto his said Britannick Majesty, and  
to his heirs and Successors forever, a certain tract or parcel of Land [situated and  
bounded as follows, to wit, Beginning at the Out Let (so called) between Burlington  
Bay and Lake Ontario, and thence extending down the said Lake on the north shore  
thereof about one mile or more to a creek falling into the said Lake, called by the said  
Messague Indians Lemabinnawon - thence running North forty five degrees west parallel  
with the former purchase line from the said Out Let and carrying the full breadth  
between the said Lines, full so far as to contain Three thousand four hundred and  
fifty acres - ]

To have and to hold the said granted and bargained premises, with all  
the privileges and appurtenances thereof to his said Britannick Majesty, and to his  
Successors, to his and their own proper use, benefit and behoof forever we the aforesaid  
Sachems, Chief warriors and principal women, hereby engaging to warrant and defend  
the said Granted premises against all claims and demands by from or under  
us or any others of the Messague Nation.
