A common resident, most abundant in southern Ontario during the migrations. Breeds occasionally in the southern portion of the Province and regularly in the interior and northward.

FAMILY PARIDÆ. NUTHATCHES and TITS.

SUBFAMILY SITTINÆ. NUTHATCHES.

GENUS SITTA

289. White-breasted Nuthatch

(Sitta carolinensis.)

A common resident, breeds throughout its range in the Province wherever there is heavy timber.

290. Red-Breasted Nuthatch

(Sitta canadensis.)

A resident species, but most frequently observed during the migrations. In winter it is fairly common. I once found a pair evidently breeding near Toronto, and it regularly breeds in the interior and northward.

SUBFAMILY PARINÆ. TITMICE.

GENUS PARUS.

SUBGENUS PARUS.

291. Chickadee

(Parus atricapillus.)

A very common resident, breeds throughout its range in the Province.

292. Hudsonian Chickadee.

(Parus hudsonicus.)

In southern Ontario this is only a very rare straggler from the north.

FAMILY SYLVIIDÆ. KINGLETS, GNATCATCHERS, ETC.

SUBFAMILY REGULINÆ. KINGLETS.

GENUS REGULUS.

293. Golden-crowned Kinglet.

(Regulus satrapa.)

An abundant migrant and common winter resident. Probably breeds in our northern forests.
