The Mealy Wheat

They have a new wheat in Michigan, which is called the mealy wheat. It is a bald, red, or amber wheat, with small grain, but is sold to weigh heavy. The grain shows a large percentage of gluten, which is heavier than starch. The straw is strong and the wheat should be hardy. The heads are compact and average from 4 to 4% inches in length.
