The last train connecting with the mail steamer at Quebec leaves Toronto on the Wednesday morning.

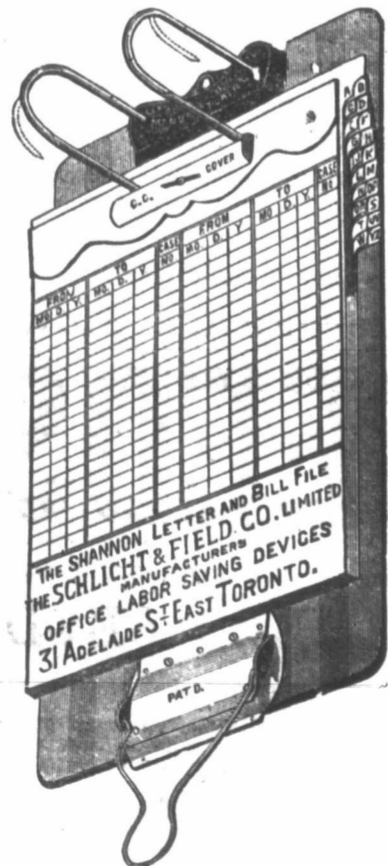

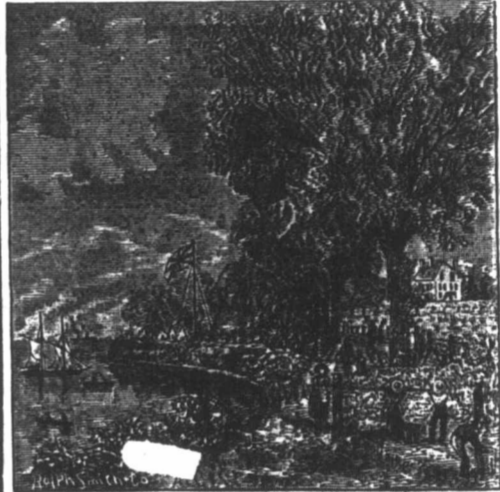
