At the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of the Province of Nova-Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on Thursday, the Thirteenth Day of February, 1823, in the Fourth Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Fourth, by the Grace of GOD of the United Kingdom of Great-Britain and Ireland, KING. Defender of the Faith, &c. &c. &c. being the Third Session of the Twelsth General Assembly, convened in the said Province.\*

## CAP. I.

An ACT for applying certain Monies therein mentioned, for the fervice of the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty-three; and for appropriating fuch part of the Supplies granted in this Session of the General Assembly, as are not already appropriated by the Laws or Acts of the Province.

May it please your Excellency,

TE. His Majesty's dutiful and loyal Subjects, the House of Assembly of His Majesty's Province of Nova-Scotia, towards appropriating the Supplies granted to His Majesty in this Session of the General Assembly, and for supplying the Exigencies of His Majesty's Government, do humbly beseech that it may be enacted, and,

I. BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That, by or out of fuch Monies as now are, or from time to time shall be and remain, in the Public Treasury

of this Province, there shall be paid :---
