On motion of Mr. Blanchet, seconded by Mr. Bruneau;

ORDERED, that the question of concurrence be put on Friday next, upon the amendments reported by the Committee of the whole House to the faid Bill.

The other orders of the day being read ;

On motion of Mr. Debartzch, seconded by Mr. Robitaille ;

ORDERED, that the faid orders of the day be postponed 'till Friday next.

- RESOLVED, that this Houfe will, on Friday next, refolve itfelf into a Committee of the whole Houfe, to take into confideration the amendments made by the Legislative Council to the Bill intituled An AC to continue in force the leveral Laws empowering the Justices of the Peace to make Rules and Regulations of Police within the Cities of *Quebec* and *Montreal*, and Town of *Three Rivers*; and alfo Rules and Regulations for the government of Apprentices and others; and for extending Regulations of Police to other Towns and Villages, in certain cafes; and which amends one of the faid ACts."
- RESOLVED, that this House will, on Friday next, refolve itself into a Committee of the whole House, further to confider the Bill for erecting a Bridge over the River Montmorency, and to provide the means for defraying the expenses and maintenance thereof.
