CAP. V.

An ACT to provide for the Banishment of Persons convicted of certain Offences, and also to provide certain modes of Punishment in divers Criminal Cases.

[12th June, 1834.]

HEREAS it is expedient to make further provision for the Preamble. punishment of Persons convicted of certain Offences in Newfoundland, and to authorize the infliction of other punishments upon Offenders than those which may now be legally awarded: Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly of Newfoundland, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, that when Offenders liable to any Person shall be convicted of any crime for which he or she shall transportation or corporal punishment be liable by Law to be Transported, or to receive any Infamous or may, under this Act, Corporal Punishment, the Court before which such Person shall be be banished; be banished; be banished; be banished; be banished; be banished; instead of the sentence of Transportation, or of such Infamous or Corporal Punishment, shall and may, should it think fit so to do, order and adjudge that such person be Banished from this Island, for and during such a number of Years, or for Life, as to the Court in its discretion shall seem meet: and shall also adjudge that such person be confined and kept to Hard Labour, until such person may, under this Act, be banished; such person be confined and kept to Hard Labour, until such person and kept at hard shall have procured, or have been provided with, a passage to some be provided.

Port or Place, beyond the Government of Newfoundland, and shall have been there landed, put on shore, and discharged by the Master of the Vessel.

II.—And be it further enacted, that it shall and may be lawful for the Sheriff of Newfoundland for the time being, or for any Justice of Peace to contract the Peace having jurisdiction where such person shall have been with masters of vesconvicted, to contract with the Master or Owner of any such Vessel, sels for such passbound for any Port not being within the Government of this Island, for the removal of any Convict under sentence of Banishment; and upon delivering such Convict on board such Vessel, to issue his Warrant to the Master of such Vessel, committing the said Convict to the custody of such Master, who shall thereupon be punishable
