CHAP. 49.

An Act respecting the Algoma Central Railway Company.

[Assented to 7th July, 1900.]

WHEREAS the Algoma Central Railway Company has, by Preamble. its petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. Section 8 of chapter 50 of the statutes of 1899 is 1899, c. 50, s. 8 amended. amended by striking out all the words after the words “St. Mary River” in the fourth line thereof, and substituting therefor the words, “to a point between Magpie and the Michipicoten Rivers, and thence to the main line of the Canadian Pacific Railway, and southerly to Michipicoten Harbour upon Line of railway. Lake Superior.”
