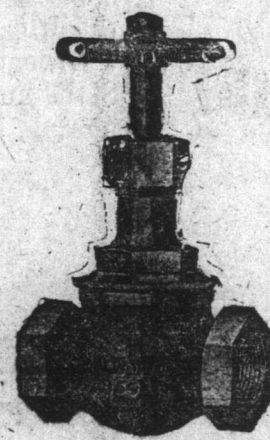

1 12-H.P. SEAL ENGINE, in first class condition.

Here are a few of its important points: No water pump is necessary, the circulation around the jacket causes a natural flow of water. The crankshaft is enclosed in a case which carries the lubricators to the bearings. The crank dome cover can be removed with half the bearings for inspection of piston and connecting rod, without dismantling the engine. The valve gear can be removed independently of cylinder, the head of which is below the water line. The water circulation is automatic. Each down stroke gives an oil drip on the connecting rod, thus supplying free lubrication. The fuel is controlled by an automatic inlet valve; once set by the regulator it requires no further attention. After five minutes running of the engine the automatic timed ignition takes up the firing, being operated by a bulb, which becomes red hot and ignites the mixtures at the correct moment by the plunger which admits fresh mixture to the bulb. It is of the four stroke type and runs 600 revolutions a minute.
