



POTATOES.—Slice cold boiled potatoes. A saucerful is enough for a large mess. Into the fryingpan put a tablespoonful of butter or fat. Slice in an onion, and fry it a minute. Push the onion to one side of the pan. and put in two teaspoonfuls of flour. Stir the flour till it is brown, then pour in quickly a cup of cold milk and rub smoothly. As the gravy thickens add more milk or water till it is ast thick as good gravy should be. Add salt and pepper. Then pour in the sliced potatoes, cover and set back on the stove till they are hot. Serve in a pretty dish.


