

JOHN CRONYN, M.D.—Dr. John Cronyn, of Buffalo, was well known to the profession in Toronto and throughout Ontario. He was born in Ireland in 1825, and came to Toronto in 1843. He commenced the study of medicine in 1855, and received the degree of M.B. from the University of Toronto in 1859, and M.D. in 1860. After graduating, he went to Buffalo, and was one of the most successful physicians in the city. He attended many of the meetings of the Ontario Medical Association, and was one of its honorary members. He was a well-educated and cultured gentleman, and a thoroughly good physician, not only beloved, but highly respected by all who had the pleasure of his acquaintance.
