Dissolve the spermaceti in the almond oil, and while warm mix it with the glycerin, potassiem carbonate, and remainder of the water. Transfer to a warm mortar, gradually incorporate the warm soap-solution, and continue to stir until a smooth paste is obtained. With this incorporate any suitable perfume.

Bicycle Rim Cement.

Frank Edel, a practical druggist, sends the following to Merck's Report. A good thick shellae variush with which a small amount of castor oil has been mixed will be found is a very excellent bicycle rim cement. The formula recommended is as follows.

Mix and dissolve, and add one half ounce of castor oil. The easter oil prevents it from becoming hard and brittle.

Holzisot - A solution of formaldehyde in methylic alcohol with the addition of a small proportion of menthol.

GERMOL —An antiseptic which is very analogous to cresol. It is a reddish brown liquid, easily soluble in alcohol.
