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Fire Chief Tremblay discussed the convent fire on St.
 Joseph Boulevard before the Montreal Board of Control re-
 cently. The board has decided that a thorough investiga-
 tion must be held into the circumstances. According to
 Chief Tremblay the fire had its origin in a dust bin that
 was connected with every room by a system of chutes. This
 enabled the fire to spread quickly. Carpenters were at
 work altering the chutes when the fire broke out. On the
 opinion of the chief the building was doomed by the time
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Mr. Edward Beauline, a resident of L'Original, Ont.,
 is in the county jail awaiting trial on a charge of incendiar-
 ism. Inspector H. Reburn, of the Attorney-General's de-
 partment, Toronto, has been investigating the causes of
 recent fires and on being questioned Mr. Beauline admitted
 his guilt.

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
