Mercantile Summary

THE new traffic rates issued by the Cana-
dian Pacific Navigation Company, in con-
nection with the White Pass and Yukon
route, and the Upper Yukon service of the
Canadian Development Co., show a gen-
eral reduction over those of last year,
ranging from 40 to 60 per cent.

ROSSLAND BOARD OF TRADE.

TELEGRAMS AND MOTHERS-IN- LAW AND FATHERS-IN-LAW AND MENTAL ANGUISH.

In the case of Davidson et al., v. West-
ern Union Telegraph Company, the Ken-
tucky Court of Appeals held that the law
does not presume from the relationship
of son-in-law and mother-in-law such
affection as will authorize the son-in-law
to recover for mental anguish caused by
the failure to deliver a telegram announc-
ing the mother-in-law's illness whereby
he is prevented from being present at her
death.

In the case of the Western Union Tele-
graph Company v. Steinberger, the same
court held that a father-in-law cannot re-
cover for mental anguish on account of
the absence of the son-in-law at the death
of his mother-in-law, resulting from the
telegram company's failure to deliver
promptly a telegram announcing the
mother-in-law's illness, there being no
blood relationship, and therefore no legal
presumption of such affection as would
authorize such a recovery.

In the latter case the court held that
where the office hours of the company at
the place where the message was to be
delivered were from seven o'clock in the
morning to seven o'clock in the evening,
the company was under no obligation to
deliver a message received during the
night, until within a reasonable time after
seven o'clock next morning.
