Yet it is good to know that the Commonwealth  
will be more peaceful and less turbulent if its  
members are willing to accept the principles of  
international law as well as friendly relations  
and a peaceful settlement of disputes among  
Commonwealth members themselves, as well as  
between the Commonwealth and other countries.  
Asia is at a time when many nations are  
men and women who have had little or no  
experience with international co-operation  
ever before. All those who have  
been involved in the Commonwealth  
are invited to help them to learn  
from their own experience and  
from the experience of others.

At London, as I said, there was  
a meeting of delegates from the Commonwealth  
of the Crown, but we all agreed, without分歧  
with the exception of one delegation, to  
make the Commonwealth a truly  
international organization based on  
the principles of equality, freedom and  
justice.
