To display or hide file name extensions:

- 1. In Explorer or My Computer, from the View menu, choose Options.
- 2. In the Options dialog box, make sure the View page is selected.
- 3. To display file name extensions, deselect the *Hide file extensions for known file types* check box. or
- 3. To hide file name extensions, select the *Hide file extensions* for known file types check box.

To increase the name of the file name column in the Explorer window:

1. Drag the file name button until the column is the desired size.

To register file name extensions:

- 1. In Explorer, in the Contents window, display a file name containing an unregistered extension.
- 2. Double-click the icon for the file.
- 3. In the Open With dialog box, in the Description text box, type a description of the new file type.
- 4. In the Choose the program you want to use list, scroll down and select the program you want to associate with the file name extension.
- 5. Make sure the Always use this program to open this file check box is selected.
- 6. Choose OK.

To remove a registration:

- In Explorer or My Computer, from the View menu, choose Options.
- 2. In the Options dialog box, select the File Types tab.
- 3. On the File Types page, in the Registered file types list, select the file type you want to remove.
- 4. Choose Remove.
- 5. In the File Types warning dialog box, choose Yes.
- 6. Choose Close.
