COMMONWEALTH EDUCATION LIAISON COMMITTEE - FIRST MEETING.

THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE FIRST MEETING OF THE COMMONWEALTH EDUCATION LIAISON COMMITTEE WILL BE HELD IN LONDON ON THURSDAY, DECEMBER 17TH. THE COMMITTEE, UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SIR PHILIP MORRIS, VICE-CHANCELLOR OF BRISTOL UNIVERSITY, HAS BEEN SET UP AS A RESULT OF A RECOMMENDATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH EDUCATION CONFERENCE HELD IN OXFORD LAST JULY AND OF WHICH SIR PHILIP MORRIS WAS CHAIRMAN. THE COMMITTEE IS COMPOSED OF REPRESENTATIVES OF ALL THE MEMBER COUNTRIES OF THE COMMONWEALTH, OF NIGERIA AND ONE MEMBER FOR THE COLONIAL TERRITORIES.
