T-14	Subsection 11(3) is repealed and the following substituted therefor: “(3) The <u>chief officer</u> of customs at any port or place in Canada may, if he believes that any ship to which this Part applies is transporting, or has transported, passengers or goods or both passengers and goods without a licence, in contravention of this Part, detain the ship pending the disposition of any complaint or charge and the payment of any fine imposed in respect of such offence.”
