NUCLEAR ARMAMENTS**ADVISABILITY OF DECLARING CANADA A NUCLEAR ARMS FREE ZONE**

The House resumed from Thursday, October 29, consideration of the motion of Mr. Young:

That, in the opinion of this House, the Government should consider the advisability of declaring Canada a nuclear arms free zone by prohibiting the deployment, testing, construction and transportation of nuclear weapons and

associated equipment through and within Canada, the export of goods and materials for use in the construction and deployment of nuclear arms and further, the Government should encourage cities, provinces and states throughout the world to take similar action.
