in Medicine, with the highest honour conferred by the University.

Since then I have been one of the Apothecaries in the Montreal General Hospital for three years; and, after having attended the Medical Classes of McGill College, obtained, in 1866, from that University the degree of Doctor of Medicine and Master of Surgery. In the autumn of that year I was appointed one of the Apothecaries of the Montreal General Hospital, and am by appointment the Senior Apothecary. The manner in which I have discharged the duties of that office is referred to in the following Testimonials from the Medical Officers of the Hospital.
