

BY-LAW NO. 116.

By-Law to Provide for the Assessment of Property
Benefitted by the Pavement Hereinafter Described.

[Passed 29th Sept., 1879.]

WHEREAS the municipal council of the corporation of the Preamble.
Town of Strathroy has decided to pave that portion of Front
street lying between the western limits of Colborne street and
the eastern limits of Thomas street in the said Town with cedar
blocks.

And whereas the said council have decided to contribute the
one-half of the costs of said pavement, and to assess and levy
upon the real property to be immediately benefitted by said
pavement the remaining half.

And whereas it is necessary to provide the means of ascer-
taining and determining what real property will be immediately
benefitted by said pavement, and ascertain and determine the
proportion in which the assessment is to be made on the various
portions of the real estate so benefitted.

Therefore the municipal corporation of Strathroy enacts as
follows :

It shall be the duty of Alexander Hilton, assessor of said Assessor.
Town, to proceed at once as commissioner to ascertain and de-
termine what real property will be immediately benefitted by
said pavement, and to ascertain and determine the proportions
in which the assessment to defray the half of the cost thereof is
to be made on the various portions of the real estate so benefitted,
and report to the clerk of this council on Monday the sixth
day of October instant.
