NO MARRIAGE FOR DIVORCED BY ANGLICAN SYNOD'S VOTE

The Some Favored Privilege to Innocent Party Division Supported House of Bishops.

Quebec, Sept. 9.—(Special.)—In the Anglican Synod this morning a committee was appointed to draft an address to the Lord Archbishop on the occasion of his 50th birthday.

The synod re-assembled at 8 o'clock Saturday evening when the debate regarding the re-marrying of divorced persons was continued, the most powerful address of the day being made by Judge Fitzgerald of Charlottetown, who favored the re-marrying of the innocent person.

KOMURA SUDDENLY ILL.

Is Confined to His Hotel From Intellectual Trouble.

New York, Sept. 10.—Baron Komura is ill in his apartments at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel.

Mr. Satou, spokesman for the Japanese party, said Baron Komura became suddenly ill Saturday night, and Dr. W. B. Pritchard was called in suffering from intestinal trouble.

The Japanese have planned to leave New York next Thursday for Seattle, Washington, whence they will sail direct for Soer.

Mr. Satou today added the denial of the Japanese envoys to that of the Russians, made yesterday, that a secret treaty of peace had been agreed upon by the emperors of Japan and Russia.

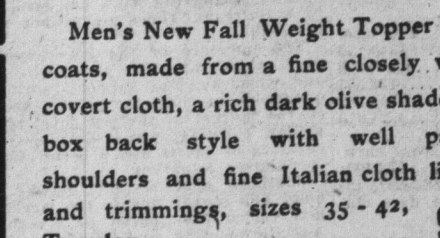
