Petrograd, Oct. 10.—The new coalition cabinet, it is announced officially, is composed of: Premier, A. F. Kerensky; minister of foreign affairs, M. I. Terestchenko; interior, N. I. Zhukovskiy; agriculture, V. I. Zhukovskiy; labor, G. V. Prokopovitch; finance, B. N. Karshteyn; public welfare, K. I. Karshteyn; justice, K. I. Karshteyn; education, S. I. Karshteyn; president of the council, P. I. Karshteyn; war, General Verkhovsky; navy, Admiral Verkhovsky; ways and communications, Verkhovsky.

Kerensky, Verkhovsky and Verkhovsky have gone to general headquarters for conferences, including one with the military attaches of allied powers. Minister of Foreign Affairs Terestchenko has also gone to headquarters.

Paris, Oct. 10.—Madame Turel, wife of Louis Turel, deputy for Coates du Nord, was arrested yesterday. The newspapers say she often changed Swiss bank notes at a Paris bank.

Louis Turel recently has been under investigation by the French chamber of deputies, because of a charge that he had been dealing with the enemy. Hints of a German bribe in connection with his case were answered by Turel that he received a large amount of money for acting as legal adviser from France.
