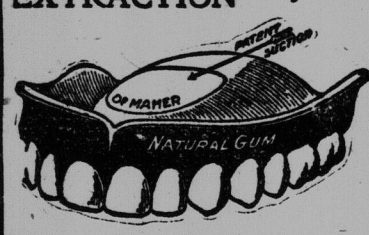

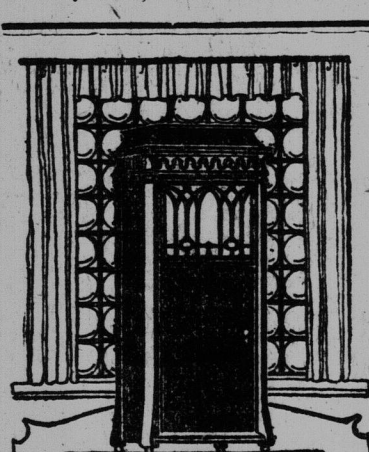

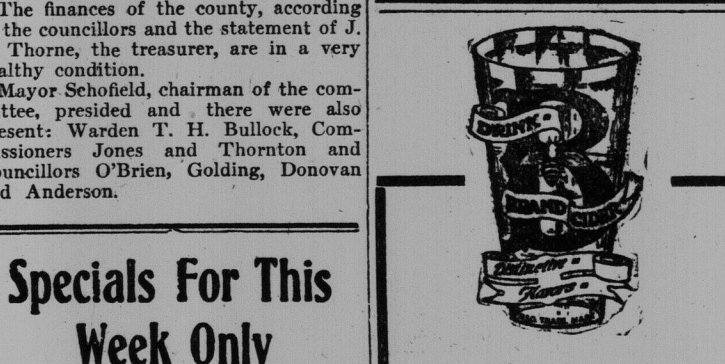
Authority was given the secretary to enforce the payment of all overdue taxes and he announced that a strenuous campaign to collect from all in arrears would commence right away. The county assessors will be asked to file with the secretary a statement with description of land, owner and information, of all properties which have been in tax arrears during the last two years.

It was decided to add the item of ten per cent. left off the Masquash tax assessment notices this year, and covering the items of discount and interest, to the assessment of 1921.

The finances of the county, according to the councillors and the statement of J. L. Thorne, the treasurer, are in a very healthy condition.
