FIRST DAY.

TUESDAY, *June 21st*, 1870.

THE SYNOD OF THE DIOCESE OF TORONTO, in obedience to the summons of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese, assembled for Divine Service in St. James's Cathedral, on Tuesday, June 21st, 1870, at 10 o'clock, A. M. Morning Prayer was said by the Rev. J. D. Cayley, M. A.; the Lessons were read by the Rev. Canon Read, D.D., and the Rev. Canon Brent, M. A. The Ante-Communion Service was said by the Ven. the Archdeacon of Toronto, the Epistle being read by the Rev. Rural Dean Geddes, M. A. The Sermon was preached by the Rev. W. E. Cooper, M. A., from the text, Phil. i. 27. The Lord Bishop of Toronto celebrated the Holy Communion, being assisted in the administration of the elements by the Very Rev. the Dean, the Rev. Canon Beaven, and the Rev. Rural Dean Givins. The Offertory was devoted to the Mission Fund of the Diocese.

At 2.30 o'clock, P.M. the Synod assembled for the transaction of business, in St. George's School-room, the Right Rev. the Lord Bishop in the Chair.
