READJUSTMENT OF PRICES.

One of the difficulties of the price readjustment period will soon be prominently before the public. It is that of procuring an evening up of reduction in the cost of services as well as of commodities. Wheat, for instance, has come down from about \$3 to \$2 a bushel, cotton from 40 cents to 20 cents a pound, hides and skins are almost given away, and reductions in manufactured products of from ten to thirty per cent. are fairly general.
