Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, in the fifty fifth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, King, Defencer of the Faith, &c."

### CAP. XXI.

An Act to grant a Salary to the Speaker of the House of Assembly of Lower Canada, to enable him to support the dignity of his office, during the present Provincial Parliament.

25th Merch, 1815. Presented for His Majesty's Assent, and reserved "for the signification of H. Majesty's pleasure thereon."
