HIS EXCELLENCY

SIR GEORGE PREVOST, Baronet,

GOVERNOR IN CHIEF.

“ **A**T the Provincial Parliament, begun and holden at *Quebec*, the twenty-first day of January, *Anno Domini*, one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, in the fifty fifth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of *Great Britain* and *Ireland*, King, Defender of the Faith, &c.”

“ Being the First Session of the Eighth Provincial Parliament of *Lower-Canada*.”

CAP. XXI.

An Act to grant a Salary to the Speaker of the House of Assembly of Lower Canada, to enable him to support the dignity of his office, during the present Provincial Parliament.

25th March, 1815. Presented for His Majesty's Assent, and referred “for the signification of His Majesty's pleasure thereon.”

Assented to by His Royal Highness, in the name and behalf of His Majesty, in His Privy Council, as signified by a Message of His Excellency the Governor-in-Chief, to the Legislative Council, on the 22^d day of January, 1817.
