An Act to establish certain Road Allowances in the Township of Grimsby.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Township of Preamble. Grimsby in the County of Lincoln have by their petition to the Legislature represented that a difference of opinion has for years past existed as to the question upon which side of 5 the original marked post or stakes in the first seven Concessions of the said Township the allowance for Roads was left, and that much difficulty therefore exists in laying out the Roads between the Concessions in the said Township, and have prayed that Commissioners may be appointed for determining 10 the said question, and it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Be it enacted, &c., That a Deputy Provincial Surveyor, to Appointment be appointed by the Commissioner of Crown Lands for the sioners to detime being, and two other persons, to be appointed by the said termine the Municipal Council, shall be Commissioners for the purposes of cortain Road 15 this Act, and are hereby authorized to proceed at any time Allowances in within one year after the passing of this Act to the said Town-vided for ship, and then or thereafter to determine with reference to each of the said Concessions, from the first to the seventh Concession inclusive, on which side of the original marked 20 stakes or posts the allowance for Road was laid off.

II. And be it enacted, that it shall be lawful for the said Commissioners Commissioners, for the purposes aforesaid, to make entry on lands for the all or any of the farms or lands lying or being contiguous or purposes of this Act. near to the Concession lines on which the said stakes or posts 25 stand or stood.

III. And be it enacted, that it shall be lawful for the said Commissionera Commissioners and they are hereby required well and truly to take evidence, enquire into all matters of fact necessary to be understood for &c. &c. &c. directing them in making their award, and by all such lawful 30 ways as are incident to a court of civil jurisdiction to compel the attendance of witnesses necessary to the investigation and the production before them of all or any deeds, books, maps, diagrams or other documents or evidence in any way relating to the matters in controversy, as well as to administer oaths 35 to such witnesses and to require them to answer any question pertinent to the matters aforesaid.

IV. And be it enacted, that so soon as the said Commis- Report and sioners shall have determined the question aforesaid they shall plan to be made cause a report and plan to be drawn up in duplicate under of Record. 40 their hands and seals, setting forth their decision, and shall
