III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said Justices at the same Special Sessions, shall appoint one respectable house-holder in each and every of the said Wards or divisions, to serve in the Office of Constable therein, for the purposes of this Act.

IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that every person who shall be appointed to the office of Constable of any Ward or division, in virtue of this Act, shall continue in office as such Constable for and during one year, and shall be annually replaced by another respectable house-holder, to be appointed Constable by the Justices of the Peace, at the time and in the manner directed by this Act.

V. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that every person who shall be appointed Constable of a Ward or Division in virtue of this Act shall, within one month from the day on which his appointment shall have been notified unto him as hereinafter required by this Act, certify and return at the Office of the Clerks of the Peace a List of all the Persons qualified to be returned and to serve as Jurors according to this Act, who shall then be resident within the limits of his Ward, together with their Titles and additions, between the age of one and twenty years and the age of sixty years.

Provided always that every such Constable, before returning the said List, shall attest the same upon oath before some Justice of the Peace of his District, to be a just, entire and faithful List, to the best of his knowledge, ability and belief.

VI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that every person who being appointed Constable of any Ward in conformity to this Act, shall refuse or neglect to certify and return such Lists within the time and in the manner required by this Act, shall forfeit and pay for every such offence a sum of

shillings *per diem* until he shall have certified and returned such List.
