INTITULED

An Act to define the Boundaries of the Colony of British Columbia, and to continue an Act to provide for the Government of the said Colony.

**W**HEREAS it is desirable to amend and continue an Act Preamble.  
passed in the Twenty-first and Twenty-second Year of  
Her Majesty, Chapter Ninety-nine, intituled "An Act to  
provide for the Government of British Columbia:" Be it therefore  
5 enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the  
Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and  
Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority  
of the same, as follows :

1. The First Section of the aforesaid Act is repealed.

10 2. The remaining Sections of the said Act shall continue in force  
till the Thirty-first Day of December One thousand eight hundred  
and sixty-three, and no longer, provided that the Expiration of the  
said Act shall not invalidate any Order in Council or other Instru-  
ment issued under Authority of the said Act, nor any Act done or
