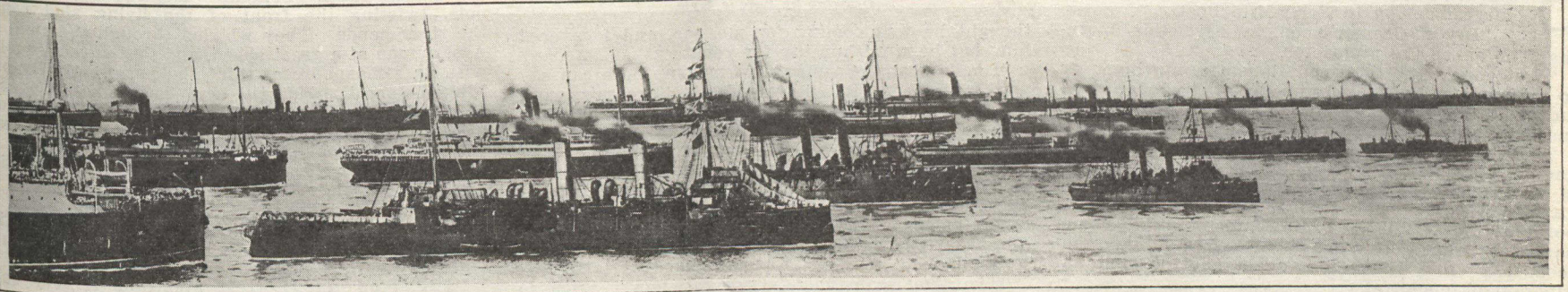


LAST GLIMPSE OF OUR ARMY IN CANADIAN WATERS
