but which was completely wrecked.



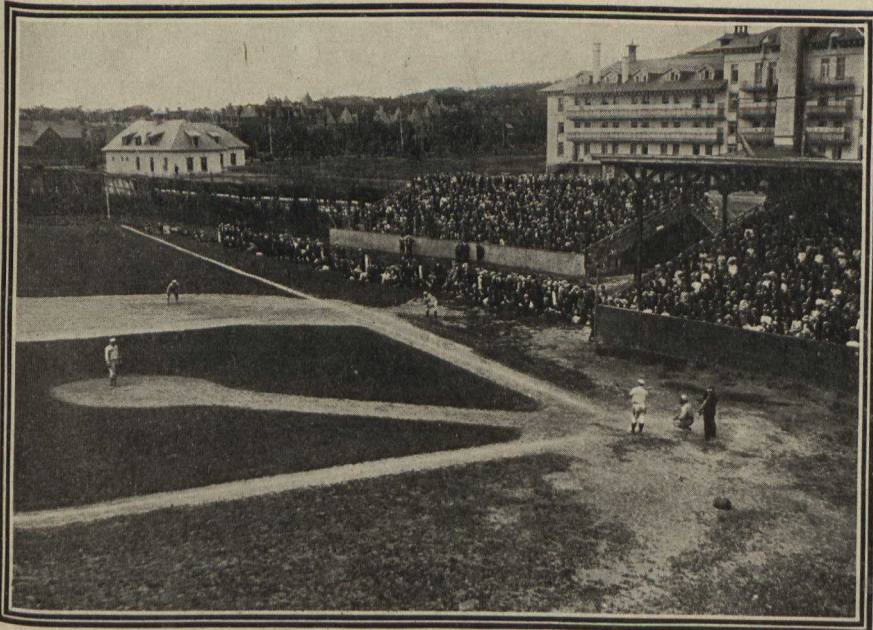
The Home of a man who was killed while sitting on his own
doorstep. The two Cities of Hull and Ottawa were badly shaken.



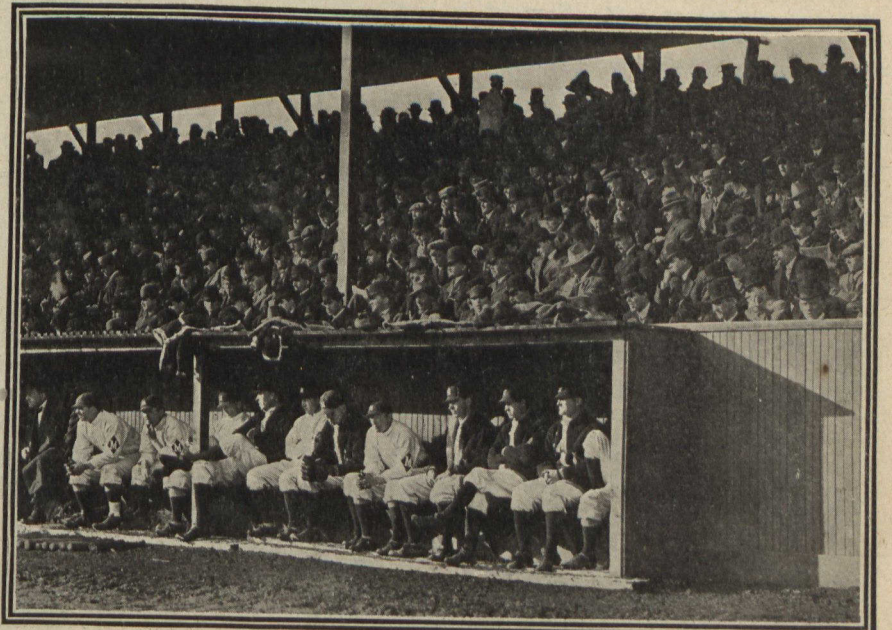
Here two little children were killed by the falling of the stones hurled from
