citizen. Thousands of our young men have been obliged to go South to find employment in the mills of Washington and Oregon, whilst thousands of Chinese operate in the mills of British Columbia. British Columbia has been robbed of these citizens, and there is scarce a home among the working people but what has felt the pinch, either because the father is out of employment, or because at least one son has been obliged to seek his fortune in a foreign land, thus depriving his family of the support he could give, except for the employing, at a lesser wage, of Chinese workers.

We seek justice for all, but we should not forget the heritage which has been handed down to us. Oriental competition is destructive of British ideals, British culture, and British standards of living.
