Canadian Potential Production: Could be tremendously increased through the breaking of new land and the substitution of barley for other grains on presently cultivated land, if market demand and prices warranted.

British Tariff Existing: Free - 10%

Remarks: The prairie provinces produce a surplus of barley, substantial quantities of which are marketed for feed in eastern Canada. Although as indicated in a separate brief, certain areas in Canada produce barley of good malting quality it is known that our exports are used chiefly for feeding purposes.
