

date, be deemed to have become a naturalised British subject, unless within that period he signed a declaration that he was not desirous of being naturalised.

(B) The Naturalisation of Aliens Act, 1910 (Act No. 4 of 1910), was repealed by the British Nationality in the Union and Naturalisation and Status of Aliens Act, 1926 (Act No. 18 of 1926). The latter Act is in force also in South West Africa, the expression "the Union" being defined by the Act to include the mandated territory of South West Africa.

(C) Similarly, the Union Nationality and Flags Act, 1927 (Act No. 40 of 1927), is in force in the Mandated Territory.

(D) The South West Africa Naturalisation of Aliens Act, 1928 (Act No. 27 of 1928), provided for the naturalisation of children of persons naturalised under Act No. 30 of 1924.
