With further reference to your letter of the 30th April last, requesting that a free Permit be applied for to the Department of the Interior in the name of Mr. J.P.G.Day, Indian Agent, Battleford, to cut 6000 Logs on available lands in the Township 52 Range 15 West of the 3rd Meridian, I beg to enclose herewith, a copy of letter which that Department has addressed to the Crown Timber Agent at Battleford, on the subject, instructing him to see that the Indians do not cut a greater quantity of timber than was authorized, namely 8000 Sawlogs.
