Rev. Sir,-

The Department has learned from Dr. Sparrow of the outbreak of small-pox at the Ekasoni Reserve and has arranged with him to render medical services. He has been told that he will be allowed payment at the rate of \$30.00 a trip to Ekasoni, but that the number of trips should be as few as possible.

Dr. Sparrow has been informed that he may purchase supplies for fumigation.

The Department desires to have you make arrangements for the issue of necessary food supplies on behalf of those Indians who are under quarantine. You should control the expenditure as it should be kept as low as possible.
