Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the Northwest Territories, excepting 8 and 28, which has not been home-siended, or reserved to provide wood lots for settlers, or for other pur-poses, may be homesteaded upon by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-cularter section of 160 acres, more or less. ENTRY. ENTRY

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the District in which the land to be taken is

situate, or if the homesteader de-sites he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, the Commissioner of Immigration, Winnipeg, or the Local Agent for the District in which the land is situate, receive authority for some one to make entry for him. A fee entry. of \$10 is charged for a homestead
