The World Wheat Crop

The work wheat Crop Preliminary estimates of the world's wheat crop for the year now opening are being offered by different authorities. Dornbusch's London List makes the indications show about posonopoo busis-els less than the high record of 1903, and slightly below the 1900 total. Ber-bohm's London List calculations reach a result 160,000,000 bushes below 1903, and about 104,000,000 bushes below 1903, bush recognizes 87,000,000 quarters, or and about 104,000,000 helow 1902. Dora-busch recognizes 87,00,000 quarters, or 696,000,000 bushels, for the curve, or 692, 000,000 bushels, for these countries-ad Ganada, for the new crops, and Beer-bolm adopts 84,00,000 pushels. For all European countries Dornbusch gives 209,200,000 quarters, and Beerbolm 193,-950,000 quarters- ad ifference of 15,-250,000 quarters- ad ifference of 15,-250,000 quarters for the year, or 5,000,000 quarters for the year.
