

Bill, intituled, "An Act to incorporate the Town of *St. Ours*."
And then he withdrew.

On motion of Mr. *Macdonald* (*Toronto West*), seconded by the Honorable Mr. *Cameron* (*Peel*),

Ordered, That the Bill from the Legislative Council, intituled, "An Act to repeal the Act to legalize certain assessments in the City of *Toronto*, and to enable the said City to recover the taxes rated and charged," be now read the first time.

The Bill was accordingly read the first time; and ordered to be read a second time, on Wednesday next.

On motion of the Honorable Mr. Solicitor General *Cockburn*, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Attorney General *Macdonald*,

Ordered, That the Bill from the Legislative Council, intituled, "An Act to amend the Law respecting the appointment of Recorders in *Upper Canada*," be now read the first time.

The Bill was accordingly read the first time; and ordered to be read a second time, to-morrow.

The House, according to Order, resolved itself into a Committee on the Bill from the Legislative Council, intituled, "An Act to enable the Municipality of the Town of *Belleville* to purchase a site for a public Cemetery, and to exempt the Roman Catholic rate-payers of the said Municipality from taxation on account of the same;" and after some time spent therein, Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair; and Mr. *Ross* (*Prince Edward*) reported, That the Committee had gone through the Bill, and made amendments thereunto.

Ordered, That the Report be now received.

Mr. *Ross* (*Prince Edward*) reported the Bill accordingly, and the amendments were read, as follow:—

Page 1, line 18,—Leave out from "2" to "*Canada*," inclusive, in line 20.

Page 1, line 21,—Leave out "said," and after "Act" insert "*Upper Canada*."

The said amendments, being read a second time, were agreed to.

Ordered, That the Bill, with the amendments, be read the third time, to-morrow.

The House, according to Order, resolved itself into a Committee on the Bill to authorize the issuing of Letters Patent of Invention to *Arthur Rankin*, for a new and hitherto unknown description of fuel, of which he has acquired a knowledge by purchase from the Inventor; and after some time spent therein, Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair; and Mr. *Ross* (*Prince Edward*) reported, That the Committee had gone through the Bill, and directed him to report the same, without any amendment.

Ordered, That the Bill be read the third time, to-morrow.

The House, according to Order, resolved itself into a Committee on the Bill to enable *Pierre Eymard Jay*, and the Honorable *Louis Antoine Dessaulles* to take out conjointly Patents of Invention for different Machines and Inventions in this Act mentioned; and after some time spent therein, Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair; and Mr. *Perrault* reported, That the Committee had gone through the Bill, and directed him to report the same, without any amendment.

Ordered, That the Bill be read the third time, to-morrow.

The House, according to Order, resolved itself into a Committee on the Bill to incorporate the Village of *New Edinburgh*; and after some time spent therein, Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair; and Mr. *O'Halloran* reported, That the Committee had gone through the Bill, and directed him to report the same, without any amendment.
