CAP. XV.

AN ACT to provide for the Contingent Expenses of the Legislature.

[Passed 31st May, 1851.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the Contingent Expenses of Preamble. the Legislature during the present Session:—

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, in Le-£4,100 0 6 grangislative Session convened, That from and out of such Monies as may tingencies of from time to time remain in the hands of the Colonial Treasurer, and Legislature. unappropriated, there be Granted to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, the sum of Four Thousand One Hundred Pounds, and Six Pence, to be applied towards remunerating the Officers of the Legislature for their Services, and towards defraying the Contingent Expenses of Her Majesty's Council and the House of Assembly during the present Session, as follows:—

The Clerk of Her Majesty's Council for his services during the present Clerk of Council. Session, One Hundred and Fifty Pounds.

The Master in Chancery for his services during the present Session, Master in Chan-One Hundred Pounds.

The Usher of the Black Rod for his services during the present Session, Usher of Black Eighty-five Pounds.

The Doorkeeper of Her Majesty's Council for his services during the Doorkeeper of Present Session, Forty-five Pounds.

The Assistant Doorkeeper and Messenger of Her Majesty's Council for Assistant ditte his services during the present Session, Twenty Pounds.
